

## Lessons from Nicodemus

### John 19:38-42

<sup>38</sup> After these things Joseph of Arimathea, being a disciple of Jesus, but a secret *one* for fear of the Jews, asked Pilate that he might take away the body of Jesus; and Pilate granted permission. So he came and took away His body. <sup>39</sup> Nicodemus, who had first come to Him by night, also came, bringing a mixture of myrrh and aloes, about a hundred pounds *weight*. <sup>40</sup> So they took the body of Jesus and bound it in linen wrappings with the spices, as is the burial custom of the Jews. <sup>41</sup> Now in the place where He was crucified there was a garden, and in the garden a new tomb in which no one had yet been laid. <sup>42</sup> Therefore because of the Jewish day of preparation, since the tomb was nearby, they laid Jesus there.

### John 3:14

<sup>14</sup> As Moses lifted up the serpent in the wilderness, even so must the Son of Man be lifted up...

### John 3:17

<sup>17</sup> For God did not send the Son into the world to judge the world, but that the world might be saved through Him.

### John 7:45-49

<sup>45</sup> The officers then came to the chief priests and Pharisees, and they said to them, "Why did you not bring Him?" <sup>46</sup> The officers answered, "Never has a man spoken the way this man speaks." <sup>47</sup> The Pharisees then answered them, "You have not also been led astray, have you?" <sup>48</sup> No one of the rulers or Pharisees has believed in Him, has he? <sup>49</sup> But this crowd which does not know the Law is accursed."

### John 7:50-52

<sup>50</sup> Nicodemus (he who came to Him before, being one of them) \*said to them, <sup>51</sup> "Our Law does not judge a man unless it first hears from him and knows what he is doing, does it?" <sup>52</sup> They answered him, "You are not also from Galilee, are you? Search, and see that no prophet arises out of Galilee."

### John 19:14

<sup>14</sup> Now it was the day of preparation for the Passover; it was about the sixth hour. And he said to the Jews, "Behold, your King!".
