1 John 3:4-10

1 John 3:4-10 (NASB)

⁴ Everyone who practices sin also practices lawlessness; and sin is lawlessness. ⁵ You know that He appeared in order to take away sins; and in Him there is no sin. ⁶ No one who abides in Him sins; no one who sins has seen Him or knows Him. ⁷ Little children, make sure no one deceives you; the one who practices righteousness is righteous, just as He is righteous; ⁸ the one who practices sin is of the devil; for the devil has sinned from the beginning. The Son of God appeared for this purpose, to destroy the works of the devil. ⁹ No one who is born of God practices sin, because His seed abides in him; and he cannot sin, because he is born of God. ¹⁰ By this the children of God and the children of the devil are obvious: anyone who does not practice righteousness is not of God, nor the one who does not love his brother.

There are two families: God's family and the devil's family.

1 John 3:4 ⁴ Everyone who practices sin also practices lawlessness; and sin is lawlessness

Practices sin: The practicing of sin is the **opposite** of practicing of **righteousness**, which **<u>1 John 2:29</u>** identifies everyone born of God.

- sin is lawlessness
- sin is rebellion against God

Practicing sin is characterized by a person who lives continually and habitually in sin.

- James 4:17 Therefore, to one who knows *the* right thing to do and does not do it, to him it is sin.
- 1 John 5:17 All unrighteousness is sin, and there is a sin not *leading* to death.
- 1 John 3:4 Everyone who practices sin also practices lawlessness; and sin is lawlessness
- 1 John 2:19 They went out from us, but they were not *really* of us; for if they had been of us, they would have remained with us; but *they went out*, so that it would be shown that they all are not of us.

1 John 3:5 ⁵ You know that He appeared in order to take away sins; and in Him there is no sin.

• John 1:29 The next day he *saw Jesus coming to him and *said, "Behold, the Lamb of God who takes away the sin of the world!

Jesus appeared to **<u>atone</u>** for the <u>**sin**</u> of the **<u>world</u>**.

• 1 John 2:2 and He Himself is the propitiation for our sins; and not for ours only, but also for *those of* the whole world.

Jesus' death on the cross as God's perfect and unblemished sacrifice, cleanses all the sins of His people.

• 2 Corinthians 5:21 He made Him who knew no sin *to be* sin on our behalf, so that we might become the righteousness of God in Him.

1 John 3:6 ⁶No one who abides in Him sins; no one who sins has seen Him or knows Him.

Patterns of repetitive sins are not indicative of a child of God.

1 John 3:7-8 ⁷ Little children, make sure no one deceives you; the one who practices righteousness is righteous, just as He is righteous; ⁸ the one who practices sin is of the devil; for the devil has sinned from the beginning. The Son of God appeared for this purpose, to destroy the works of the devil.

• John 8:44 You are of *your* father the devil, and you want to do the desires of your father. He was a murderer from the beginning, and does not stand in the truth because there is no truth in him. Whenever he speaks a lie, he speaks from his own *nature*, for he is a liar and the father of lies.

<u>Righteousness</u> is the <u>character</u> of Christ.

Sin is the character of the devil.

Luke 11:14-26¹⁴ And He was casting out a demon, and it was mute; when the demon had gone out, the mute man spoke; and the crowds were amazed. ¹⁵ But some of them said, "He casts out demons by Beelzebul, the ruler of the demons." ¹⁶ Others, to test *Him*, were demanding of Him a sign from heaven. ¹⁷ But He knew their thoughts and said to them, "Any kingdom divided against itself is laid waste; and a house *divided* against itself falls. ¹⁸ If Satan also is divided against himself, how will his kingdom stand? For you say that I cast out demons by Beelzebul. ¹⁹ And if I by Beelzebul cast out demons, by whom do your sons cast them out? So they will be your judges. ²⁰ But if I cast out demons by the finger of God, then the kingdom of God has come upon you. ²¹ When a strong *man*, fully armed, guards his own house, his possessions are undisturbed. ²² But when someone stronger than he attacks him and overpowers him, he takes away from him all his armor on which he had relied and distributes his plunder. ²³ He who is not with Me is against Me; and he who does not gather with Me, scatters.²⁴ "When the unclean spirit goes out of a man, it passes through waterless places seeking rest, and not finding any, it says, '1 will return to my house from which I came.' ²⁵ And when it comes, it finds it swept and put in order. ²⁶ Then it goes and takes *along* seven other spirits more evil than itself, and they go in and live there; and the last state of that man becomes worse than the first."

Jesus has demonstrated the power of God and has defeated the devil. To be sure satan still has power, but it is no match to the power of God.

1 John 3:9 ⁹ No one who is born of God practices sin, because His seed abides in him; and he cannot sin, because he is born of God.

- John 3:3 Jesus answered and said to him, "Truly, truly, I say to you, unless one is born again he cannot see the kingdom of God."
- John 3:5 Jesus answered, "Truly, truly, I say to you, unless one is born of water and the Spirit he cannot enter into the kingdom of God.
- John 3:7 Do not be amazed that I said to you, 'You must be born again.'

Born of **<u>God</u>** = Born <u>again</u>

His seed abides in him = God's **<u>divine</u>** nature remains in the <u>child</u> of <u>God</u>.

"The question is: Have you been born of God? I believe in the security of the believers, but I also believe in the insecurity of the make-believers. It is well for us to take an inventory and to look at our lives. We must examine ourselves and see whether we are in the faith or not. Are you a child of God? Do you long after the things of God? 1 John 3:10 ¹⁰ By this the children of God and the children of the devil are obvious: anyone who does not practice righteousness is not of God, nor the one who does not love his brother.

- John 15:1-5 "I am the true vine, and My Father is the vinedresser.² Every branch in Me that does not bear fruit, He takes away; and every *branch* that bears fruit, He prunes it so that it may bear more fruit.³ You are already clean because of the word which I have spoken to you.⁴ Abide in Me, and I in you. As the branch cannot bear fruit of itself unless it abides in the vine, so neither *can* you unless you abide in Me.⁵ I am the vine, you are the branches; he who abides in Me and I in him, he bears much fruit, for apart from Me you can do nothing.
- John 3:16 "For God so loved the world, that He gave His only begotten Son, that whoever believes in Him shall not perish, but have eternal life.
