- When it costs you something
- When pain is the price tag
- When a reputation is at stake
- When love is on the line

Five Reasons for Personal urgency in reaching out to lost people:

1. Blessed

- Psalm 67
- We have been greatly blessed. Let’s share the blessing!
- Ephesians 1:13 “Praise be to the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, who has blessed us in the heavenly realms with every spiritual blessing in Christ.”

2. Returning

- Christ is returning!
- Matthew 25:1-13 - The Parable of the 10 Virgins
- Matthew 25:13 “Therefore keep watch, because you do not know the day or the hour.”
- Jesus is coming soon!

3. Eternity

- We have been saved. We are being saved. We will be saved.
- The Rich Man and Lazarus - Luke 16:19-31, vs. 26

4. Able

- Philippians 4:13 “I can do everything through Him who gives me strength.”
- God enables us to do what He tells us to do!
- In Christ, we are able to make a difference!
- I can love a neighbor!
- I can bless the hurting!
- I can carry the needs of the wounded!
- I can visit the sick!
- I am able to love with Christ’s love.
- I am able to give without receiving in return.
- I am willing to sacrifice that others may receive.
- I can forgive the offender.
- I can care for the imprisoned.
- I can pray for my neighbors.

5. Destiny

Matthew 24:14 - “And this gospel of the Kingdom will be preached in the whole world as a testimony to all nations, and then the end will come.”
